



## Art Contest Guidelines

### Eligibility

Youth grades 4 – 12, enrolled in public, private, territorial, tribal, or home school, or through a sponsoring club in the Douglas County area.

### Theme

Positive Prevention Messages – categories include:

- Substance Abuse
- Problem Gambling
- Suicide
- Tobacco Use
- Child Abuse/Neglect
- Violence/Self-Harm
- Bullying
- General Prevention

### Artwork Requirements

- **ALL** artwork must accompany an **Entry Form** with guardian signature – *Unless participant is over 18 years old*
- Must be original
- Must be portable
- Must be appropriate for all audiences
- Must include a prevention message
- Limit of **3** submissions per student
- Media may include but not limited to: pencil, crayon, marker, paint, pen, photographs, digital art, graphic, art sculptures, poetry, video, music
- Please **DO NOT** fold artwork

### Judging Criteria

- **ALL** artwork must accompany an **Entry Form** with guardian signature
- Categories **may be combined** for judging based on volume received and quality of artwork
- 50% on creativity
- 50% on positive prevention messaging
  - Increase awareness
  - Increase understanding of consequences
  - Increase understanding of effects on people
  - Motivates to change/take action

### Submission Deadline

All art work must be submitted by April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019

### Grade Categories

- Grades 4 – 5
- Grades 6 – 8
- Grades 9 – 12

### Additional Opportunity - Problem Gambling Art Search

Youth grades 6 – 8 can also be eligible to have art work submitted for the statewide *Problem Gambling Prevention Calendar* art contest. Art work needs to be **8 ½ x 11** and on white paper. Final selection for the calendar is done by the state. Prizes will be awarded by the Oregon Health Authority. Submissions due at Adapt Prevention & Education by **March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019** for this option.

### Art Show

All art work will be displayed at the **8<sup>th</sup> Annual Art of Prevention Art Show on Thursday April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019** at the Winston Community Center.

*Doors open at 5:00pm and the presentations start at 5:30pm.*
