Contest Guidelines

All artwork must be submitted by Monday, April 8th, 2024.

Eligibility: Douglas County youth, grades 6-12, are encouraged to enter one or more (3 max) art pieces into the 2024 **Art of Prevention** art contest. Artwork must portray a prevention message within one of the categories listed below. Artwork must be received by the contest deadline (April 8th, 2024) in order to qualify for judging.

Artwork Categories:

- Substance Misuse Prevention
- Suicide/Self-Harm Prevention
- Problem Gambling/Gaming Prevention
- General Prevention/Resilience

Judging Criteria:

- 50% on Creativity
- 50% on Prevention Message
 - Increases awareness
 - Increases understanding of consequences
 - Motivates to change or take action

Artwork Requirements:

- **ALL** artwork must accompany an **ENTRY FORM** with parent/guardian signature (*unless participant is 18+ years old*)
- Artwork must be original
- Artwork must be portable
- Artwork must be appropriate for all audiences
- Artwork must include a **prevention message**
- Artwork media may include pencil, crayon, marker, paint, pen, photographs, digital art, art sculptures, poetry, video, music, or other

Contest Awards:

- **First Place: \$250**
 - **Second Place: \$150**
 - **Third Place: \$100**
- Per artwork category and grade division (6-8, 9-12)*
